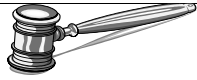
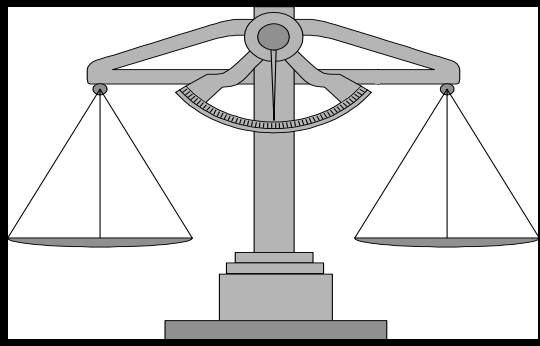

If you are a victim or survivor of domestic violence and have questions about criminal, civil or domestic relations legal issues, call the ACADV Legal Advocacy Hotline for information, referrals and explanations of Arizona's legal processes, including:

- .. Your rights in the criminal justice process
- .. Legal resources in your community or other states
- .. How and where to file for an Order of Protection and your rights if violations occur
- .. What to expect during a Contested Order of Protection hearing
- .. Your rights under the Violence Against Women Act. This is especially important to women in Tribal jurisdictions, undocumented women, as well as those battered women having out of state issues regarding their orders of protection
- .. Domestic violence, immigration and filing a self-petition for U.S. citizenship
- .. Filing for divorce, custody, visitation, etc. without an attorney
- .. Filing a criminal complaint

We also provide:

- .. Safety planning and anti-stalking resources and information
- .. Technical support to professionals who are working with victims and survivors of domestic violence

Things Domestic Violence Victims and Survivors Should Know:

- .. An Order of Protection can be obtained through any Superior, Municipal or Justice Court and is valid for one year from the date of service.
- ± However, if you have any domestic relations issues pending in Superior Court (divorce, legal separation, custody, visitation, etc.), you must file for an Order of Protection in that Superior Court.
- .. There is **no** filing fee or service fee for an Order of Protection
- .. You have the right to request that Police or Deputies take a report when a crime has occurred. This is especially important when the defendant has violated an Order of Protection but has already left the scene. Every violation should be reported to and documented by law enforcement officers.
